We ask that before you prepare and submit an article for our consideration, please send a short outline or summary to the editors to ensure that it would be of relevance to our readers.

As CES is the journal of a professional institution, articles that are written purely to promote a particular product or company will not be considered suitable matter for publishing as editorial. There is no guarantee that any submitted article will be printed

and we reserve the right to edit any article we decide to publish. All articles must be attributed to appropriate author(s) and all approval procedures with regards to image copyright, project contracts and so on must be carried out prior to submission.
